A day of team challenges lies in store on this special day: archery, Connect 4 basketball, interactive climbing wall, speed touch arena.



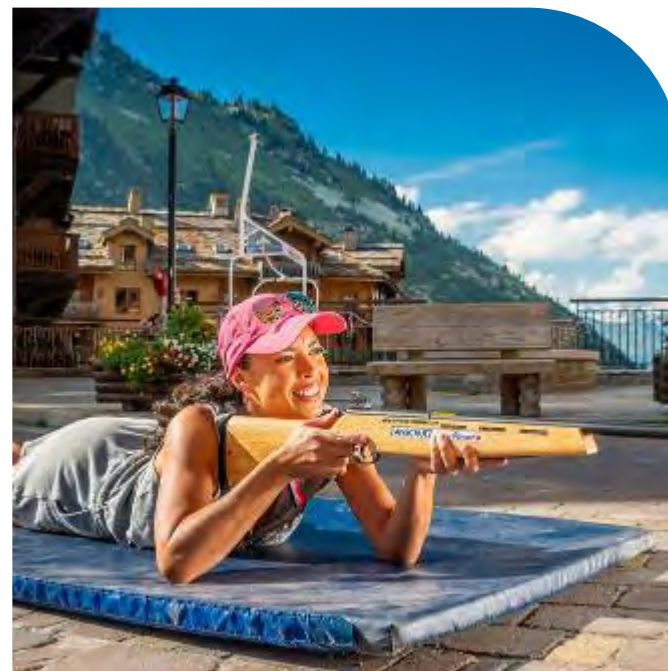
Teens & Kids Dance Workshop and Kids' Show

Hiking

The Col de la Chal, Mont Pourri or Aiguille Rouge take hiking fans into the heart of the wilderness. Leaving from the Village, walkers of every level delight in magnificent landscapes and panoramas.

Trail

Trail, a blend of running and hiking in the mountain, is an altitude training that improves physical fitness. The whole Les Arcs ski area is open to Alpine trail running.

Adventure Course

A treetop adventure course, the Aventures park offers several circuits to suit different ages and sizes.

On Two Wheels

A ride on MTB and E-MTB

The MTB and electric MTB are perfect for exploring the pathways of Les Arcs. Departing from the Village, alone or with instructors, beginner or expert, discover the fun of mountain bike descent, or family rides.

Via Ferrata

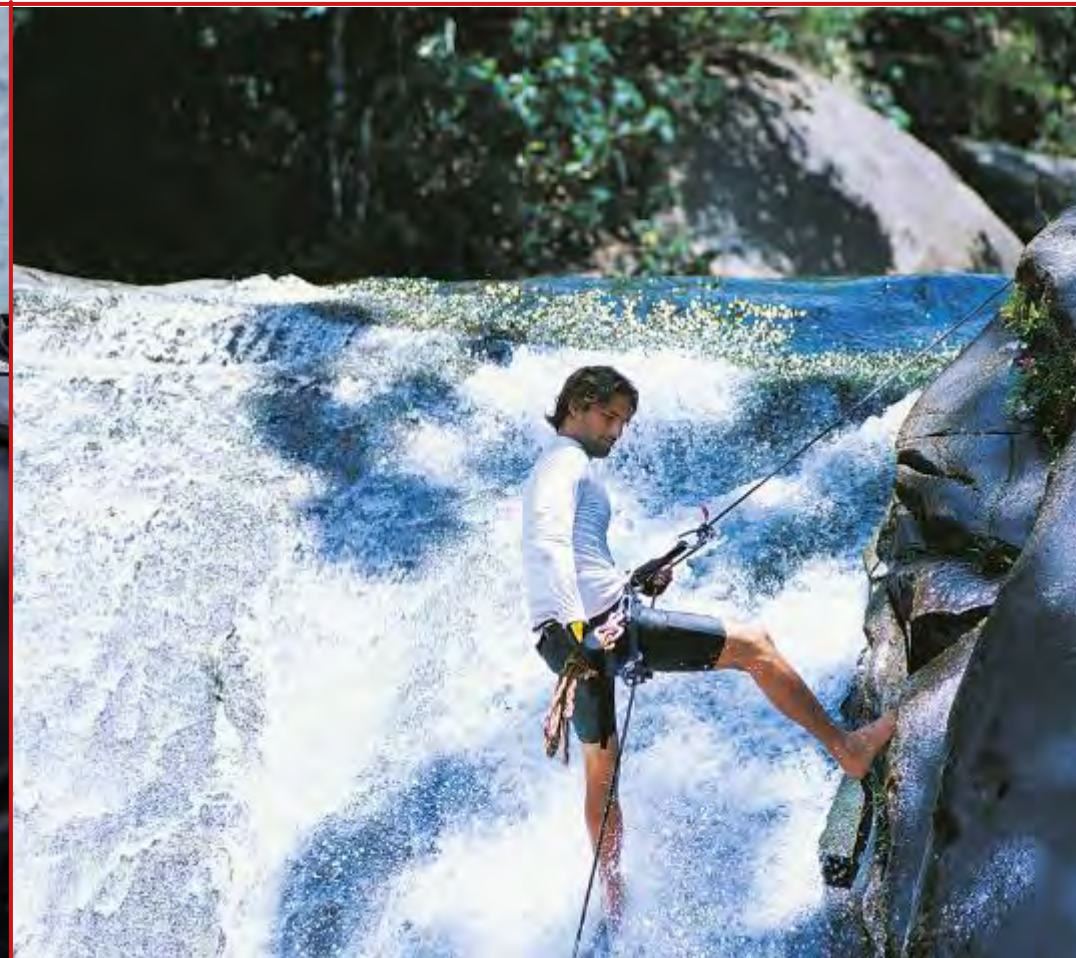

Fishing

The lakes Saint-Jacques, Marlou and Vallée de l'Arc are all near Arc 1950 and stuffed with rainbow trout! A perfect chance to indulge in a little fishing in Les Arcs. Regional fishing permit required.

Canyoning

This leisure activity includes hiking, white water swimming and abseiling. Enjoy leaping, sliding, bathing in pools, abseiling behind waterfalls... Departure from the Bourg-Saint-Maurice canyoning centre.

Rafting and Hydrospeed

Whether you already love adrenalin and white water sports or are dipping your toes in the water for the first time, try rafting or hydrospeed at the Landry "Eau Vive" base. Navigate on the river Isère, one of the steepest rivers for the practice of these sports.

Cariboo's Club: teens and kids' paradise

The Cariboo Club courses and activities help children of all ages make new friends and great memories:

- Cariboo Creche cares for your youngest (9 months to 3 years).
- Cariboo Sports Outdoor welcomes children of 3 to 12 years, introducing them to activities like archery, mountain survival, hiking, treetop adventure, zip-wire, blowgun, golf, MTB, scooter...
- Children's MTB is a 3 day course for 6 to 11 year olds united by a common passion, the bike.

“Green” restaurants proposing homemade, locally sourced and organic dishes



- *8 à Huit Supermarket*: a delicatessen aisle stocks fresh and homemade products daily. The shop also has some organic and unpackaged produce.
- *Wood Bear Café*: a variety of dishes with organic, vegetarian, vegan and gluten-free options. Fruit harvested from the restaurant's kitchen garden.
- *Cascade Sucrée*: pasta with homemade sauce and Savoyard specialities like the Hot Diot. A local interpretation of the famous hot dog, the Hot Diot is crusty bread stuffed with a doit braised in white wine.
- *Gourmet Montagnard*: charcuterie, cheese, soups, drinks... from Savoie. Including Genepi and jams actually made by the manager!
- *Perce Neige*: Products purchased in a short supply chain.

Le Mazot and La Brasserie 1950 also propose Vegan/VG dishes for lunch and dinner, as well as products purchased in a short supply chain from local businesses e.g.: Alpes Viandes, La Fromagerie de la Cochette and La Cooperative Laitière de Bourg-Saint-Maurice.

The closest SNCF stations to Arc 1950 the Village is that of Bourg-Satin-Maurice, approximately 35 minutes from the Village.

By shuttle

Shuttle buses serve pedestrians and cyclists between Bourg-Saint-Maurice and Arc 1600 this summer, as the funicular railway is not operational. The shuttles run about every 35/40 minutes at the same price as the funicular for a pedestrian (€3 one way / €5 return).

From Arc 1600 the inter-resort shuttle buses are free. They regularly serve Arc 1950 le Village and other sites in Les Arcs.
